Everybody wants to tell her what to do

Hey guys how's it going this is Jacqueline the unimportant homemaker and Today let's talk about authority.

In the beginning, Lord God gave instructions to the man. When the woman answered the serpent, she responded with an extra phrase in addition to what the Lord God told Adam. So some assume the man told the woman to not even touch the fruit. But the serpent tricked the woman. That makes 4 individuals who gave the woman instructions. God, her husband, the evil one and herself. Because she reasoned that the food did look good to her and could make one wise.she sought her own counsel.

Everybody wants to tell the woman what to do.

But who did her maker give that authority to? Her husband. The giver of all authority gave the authority to her husband. So the wife is to subject herself and be obedient to her own husband.

Let's look briefly in this video why each individual wants to tell the woman what to do..

## Herself

She has her instructions, from God and her husband, but she allowed the evil one to trick her into disbelief while she also judged the situation with her eyes and desire for more. This sounds so much like women, right. We know the right thing to do, Titus 2, proverbs 31, the marriage vows we made, but yet, our eyes see something else that looks good, like the right to make our own decisions, and our desire wants more than we have. So she has the inclination, very, very often to disregard what she was instructed by the Lord God and instead, be seduced by the evil one and her own fleshly desires.

## The evil one

He wants to thwart God's plan, he has from the beginning. He is a liar, a deceiver, a destroyer and also a reader of the word of God. Remember Satan quotes Scripture. But he hates God and all of his plans and all of those who are loyal, blood bought children of the Father and He would love to deceive the woman. So he twists scripture, and shows her that she can have wisdom instead and that they are keeping something from her and that she won't have real consequences on her decision. This makes sense because women are always, always, always absolutely positive they are smarter than men, especially their own husbands. And she likes what the world has to offer because the world doesn't ask her to submit herself to no man, she don't even need a man. So she gets tricked, again, to leave the leadership of her husband and her Lord and instead do her own thing and lead her husband by the nose over to her side.

## Her husband
