

Committed to not blaspheme

Hey guys, how's it going ... and today let's talk about blasphemy.

Call yourself blessed, you who do the whole counsel of the Lord. Turn from those women who proclaim salvation or love for the Lord while rejecting his order in his revealed word

Refuse to take a stand on the prophecy of the preacher lady. Refuse her courses, her books, her teaching and instead, hold fast the word of God. The Lord knows that we are easily influenced, often by the worst people for us so He has instructed born-again, faithful women to teach younger wives because she will have a different motive for doing so.

Exalting the word of God and the glory of God is the impetus of the older woman's pursuit in teaching good things.

The bible tells us that she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please her husband. Our interests are divided, because we have a husband and the Lord God has instructed us on how we can honor and please Him while we do the things of married life. That is what Titus 2 is all about. The older woman understands that a wife needs to do as the Lord wills concerning her life within marriage so that she won't make an idol out of marriage or husband, or cause unbelievers to speak reproachfully about the Word but will become the woman the Lord desires her to become, balanced, moderate, fit for every good work. In verse 4 Paul uses a Greek word that we translate as teach or train, which actually means to bring a person to their senses. If a woman is not loving her husband and children and living her life in a godly manner, she is not in her right mind. She is carnal of mind and is in need of instruction so that she may conform herself as she ought to, lest the word be blasphemed.

If she fails to be transformed by the word so as to obey it, it could be a discouragement to the new believer who reads the word and wonders why every single professing christian woman she knows decided to disobey the word of God but keep proclaiming loudly that He is in fact her Lord, when He clearly doesn't command her life. This could make the young woman think she can disobey as well and still receive the prize of the upward call of Christ. let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.

And the unbeliever, she will scoff as she says she calls herself a christian, my grandma was a christian and she didn't act like that at all. Or worse, your unsaved husband and children, who will have a front row seat to see a christian live her life, they may turn and curse God and His word because you are harsh, unloving, unkind, fast & loose,

disobedient and insubordinate. You have the greatest opportunity to show the transformative power of the Spirit of God every single day as you conform to the Word because it will directly impact, for good or for evil, the husband and children gifted to you to steward and serve. Your family is watching this and learning from it. This is how good or evil gets repeated and normalized. Women have the greatest capacity to affect the entire household. Let it be for good and for the glory of God.

What about you? Have you praised a woman you know whose life matches the bible? I ask, because it's important we show that we see & value the good things of God and give honor where honor is due. We don't mind congratulating a woman for a promotion at her job or for getting a new car or some other temporal thing but what about the woman who seeks the blessing of God by living as He commanded? I am so blessed everytime I talk to one of you ladies who show by their lives they love all the ways of the Lord!
