I think a very good place to start is to take a look at the book of Romans.

Romans has a very...interesting take on the natural use of the woman. Now if you are "open minded" and "modern" this may offend you. But the truth is that to deny this is to live in a delusional bubble and pretend like you don't already know and understand this.

Romans chapter 1 says women did change the natural use into that which is against nature And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another;

So in a very real and very mature way, we see that the woman has a specific use.

Please don't let that phrase offend you but use your maturing mind to be realistic.

You share in that special use with your husband, you desire his desire towards you regarding that special use, the violation of that use when given to another besides your spouse could result in divorce, and in 1st Timothy when a couple needs to refrain from the use, they are instructed to come back together quickly lest Satan move against them with temptation. So this is a very important aspect of marriage.

God safe guarded it by saying the marriage bed is undefiled. You know what, I think he put that there very specifically because one of the tools Satan uses to manipulate and destroy a marriage is to fill her head with thoughts and fears that will shut her out from enjoying her marital benefits.
